Objective: Gross motor skills training

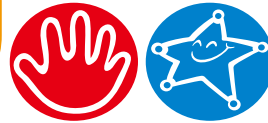
Method: Parents can encourage children to grab the blocks with both their right and left hands. Children can also squeeze the crinkly blocks and shake the block with a rattle in it.

Method: Encourage children to stack 2-3 blocks, one on top of the other. This activity trains children's balancing skills and patience.

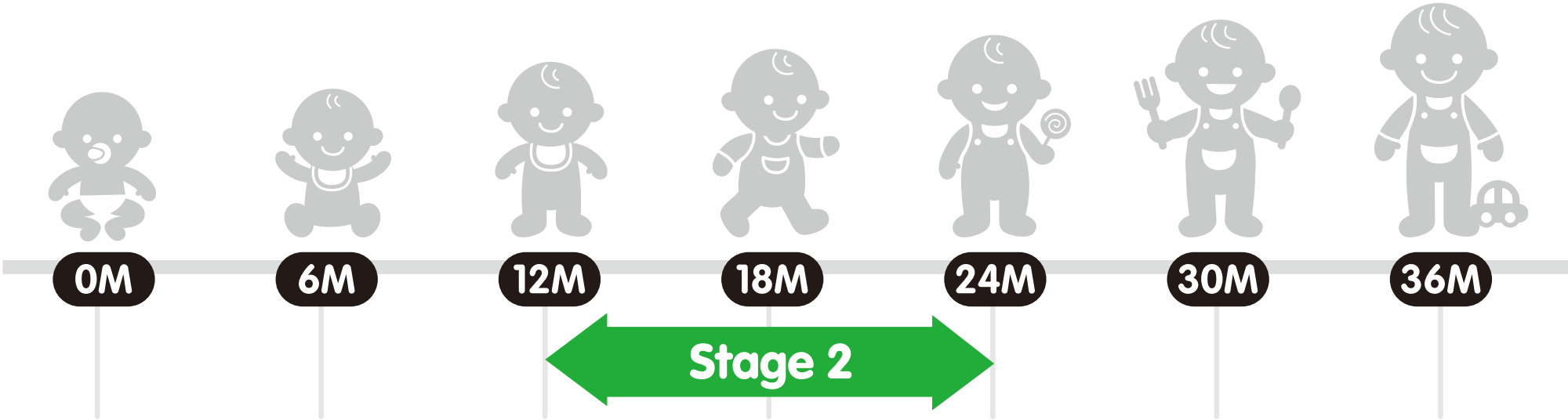
