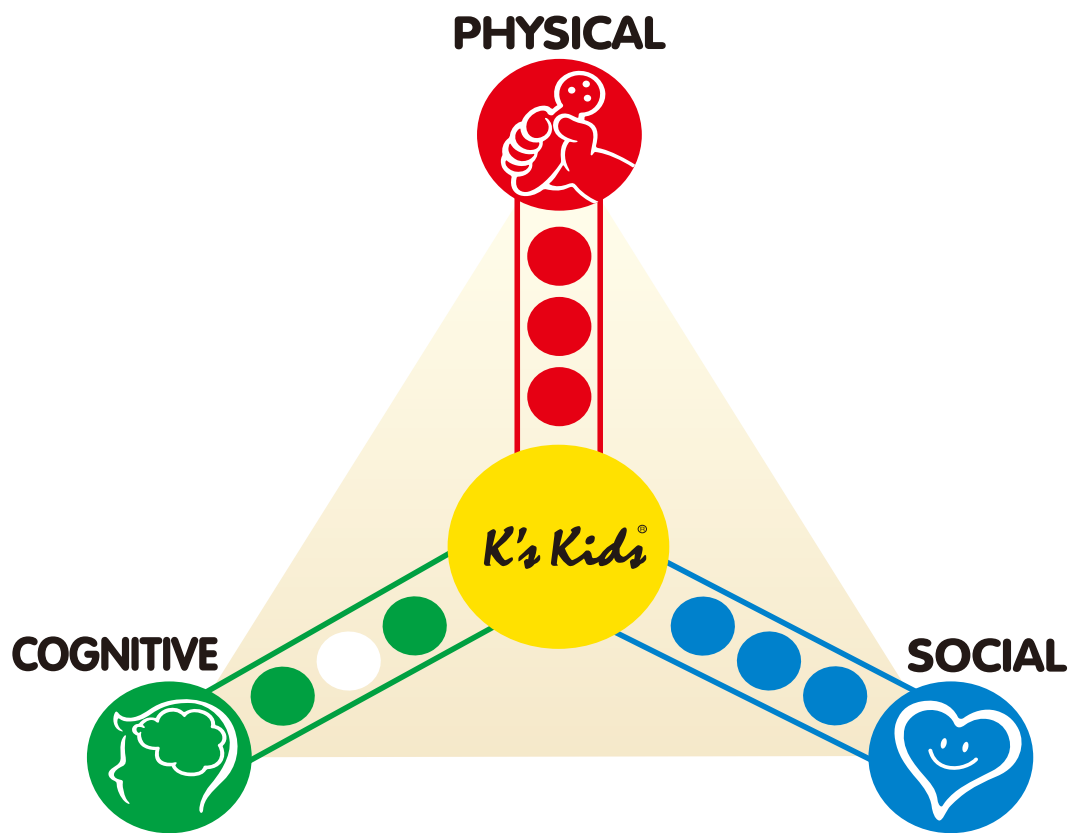

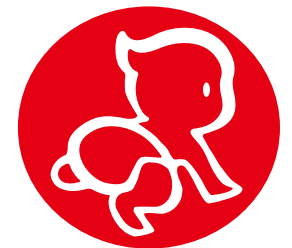
K's Kids Learning Triangle®

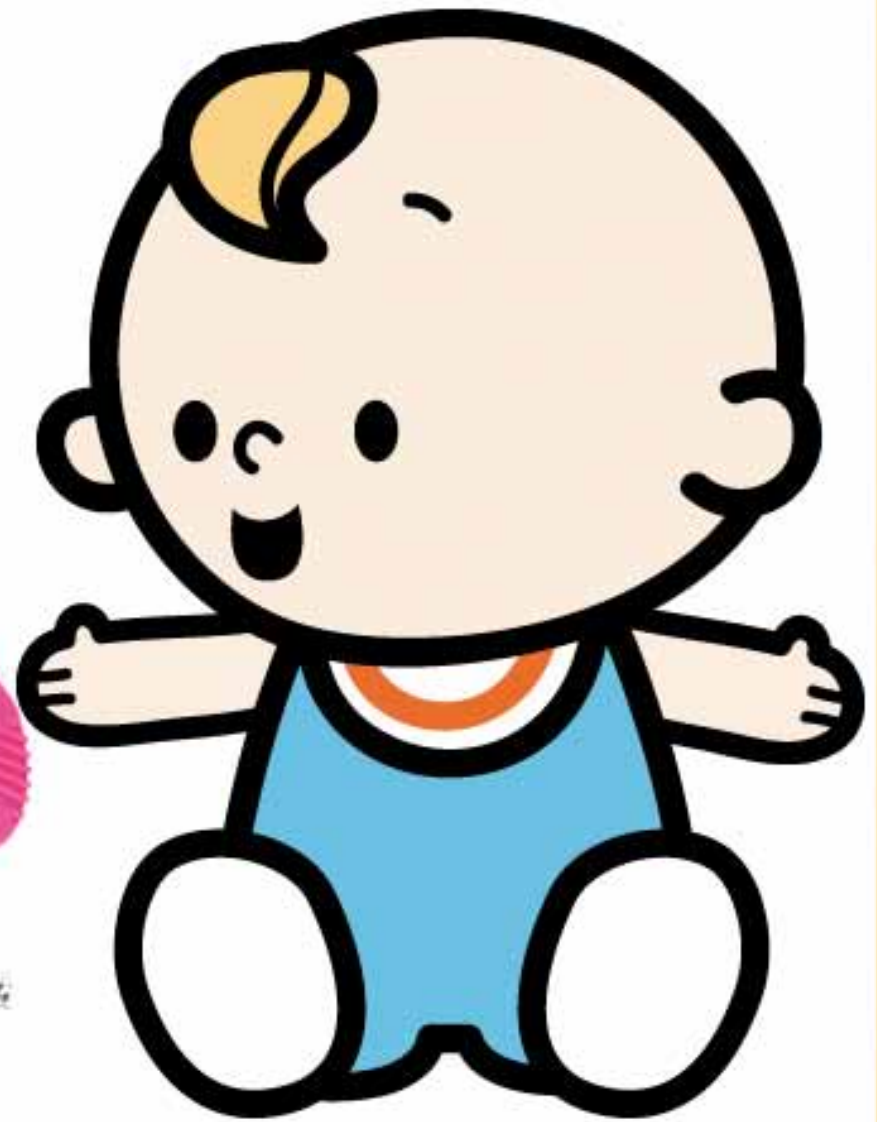
Activity 1.1

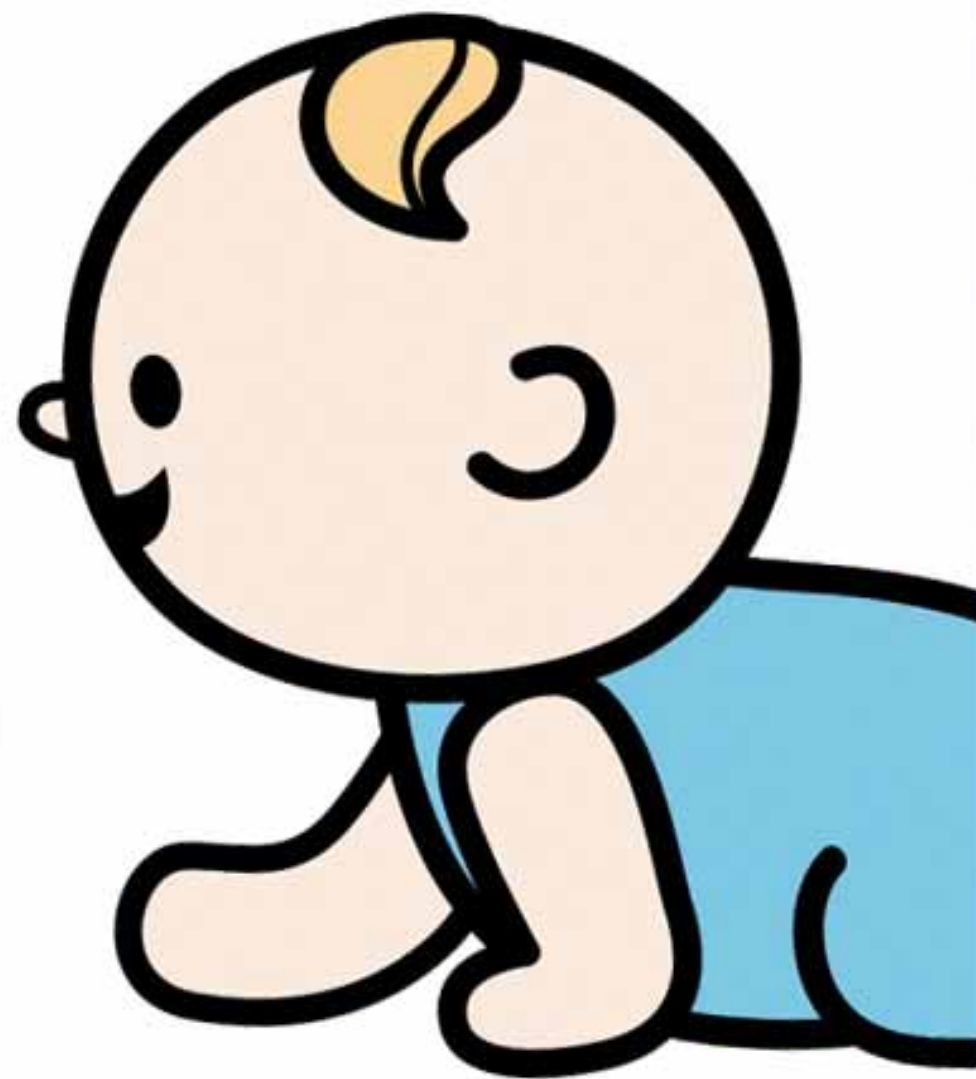
Activity 1.5

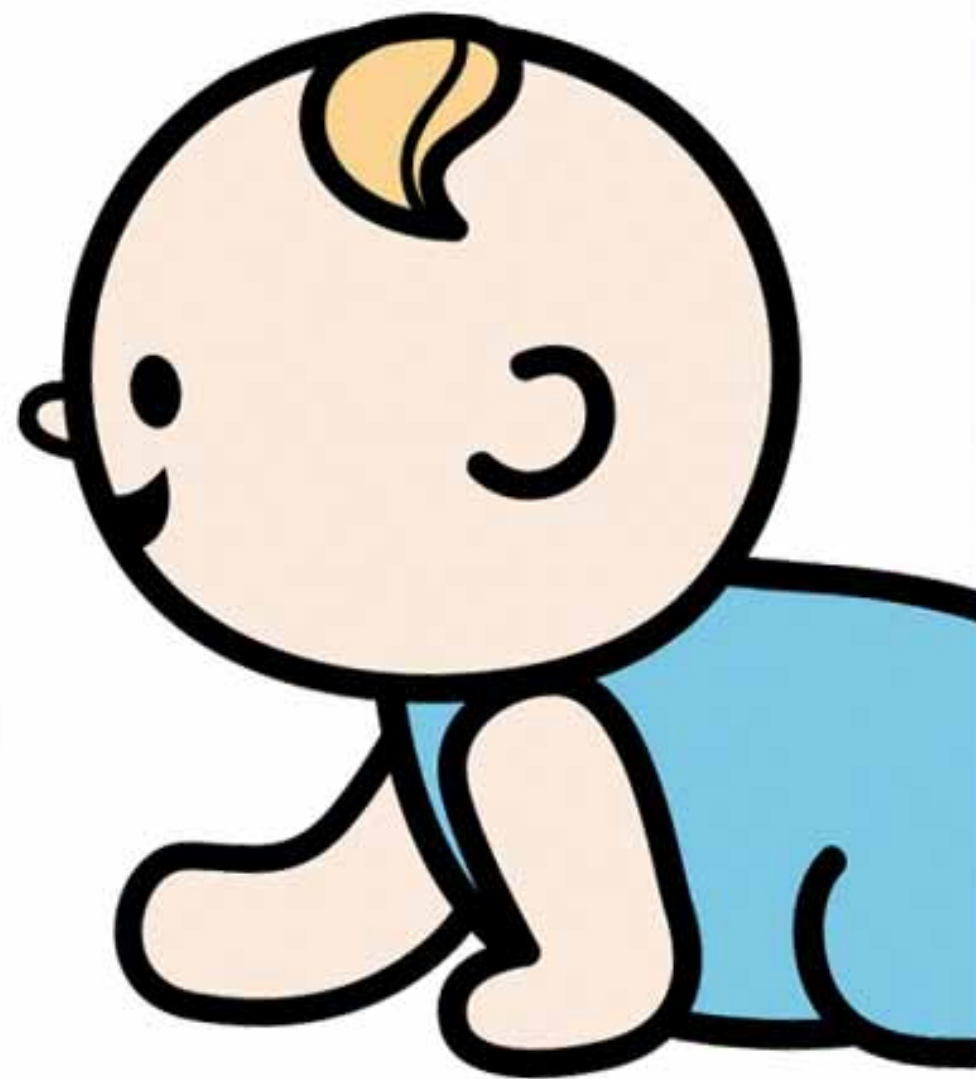
Activity 1.6

Method: Encourage your child to observe and recognize her own image in the mirror. This builds up her self image.

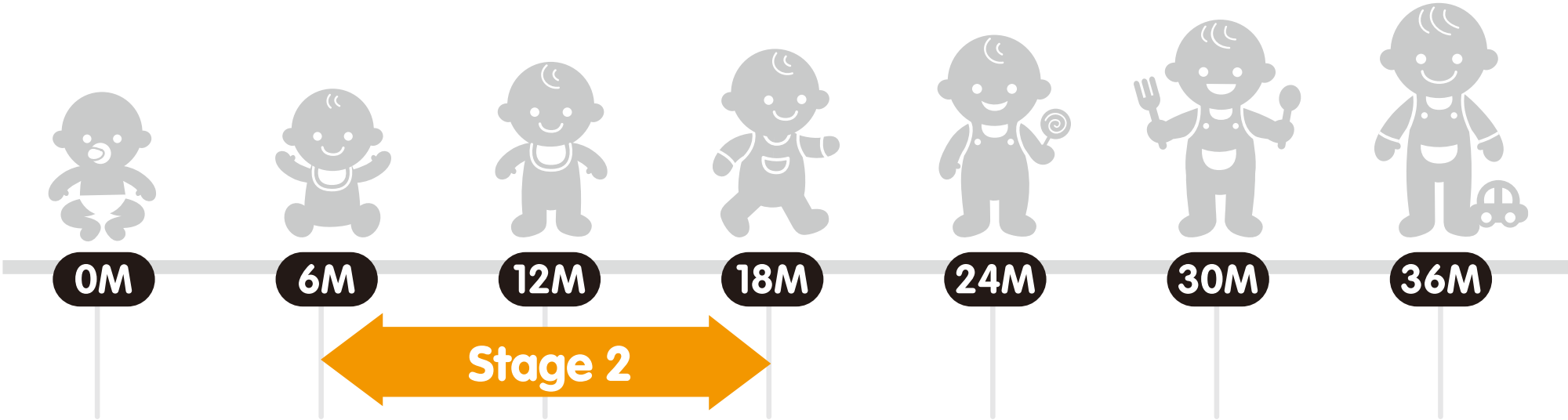

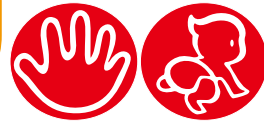

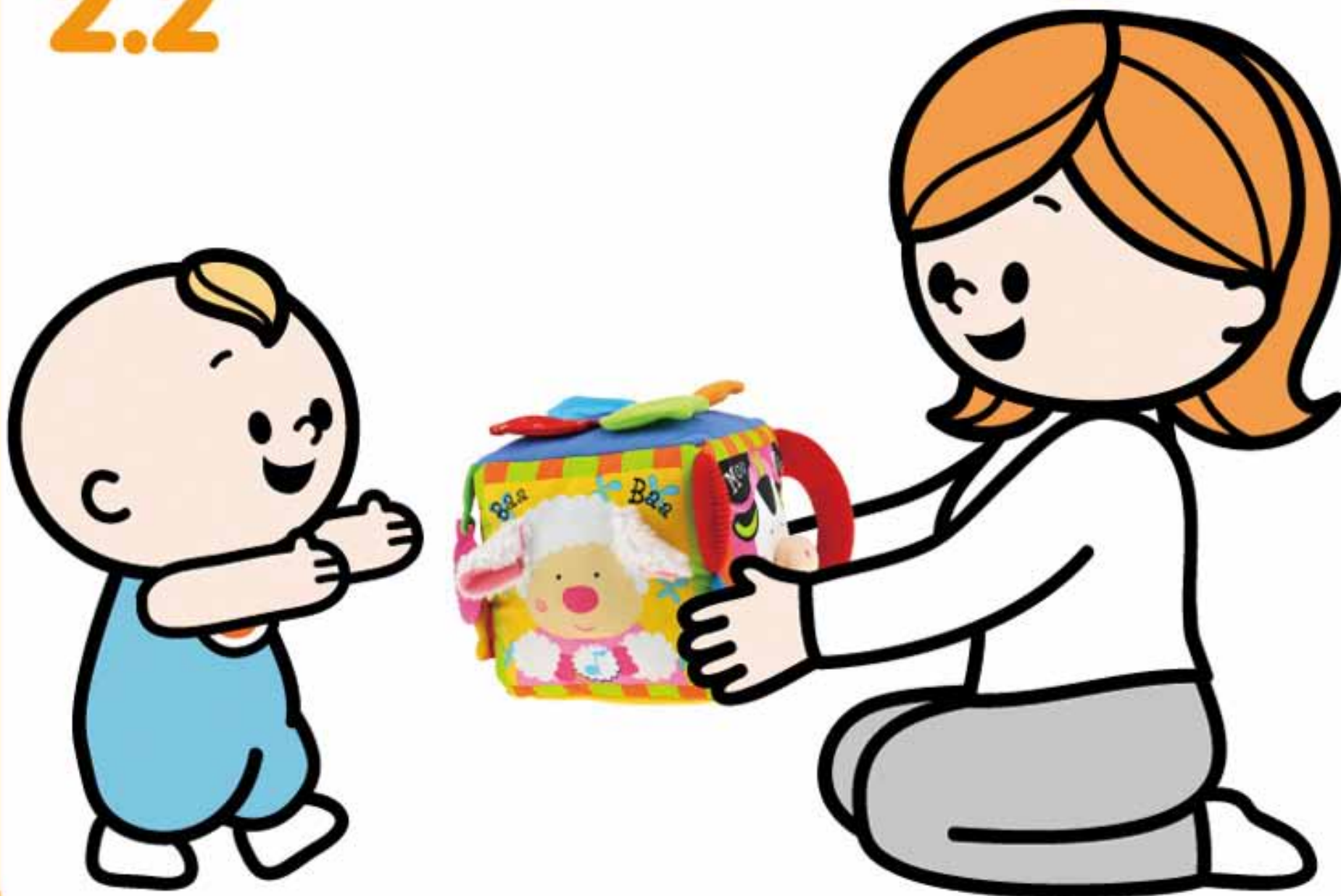
Activity 2.2
