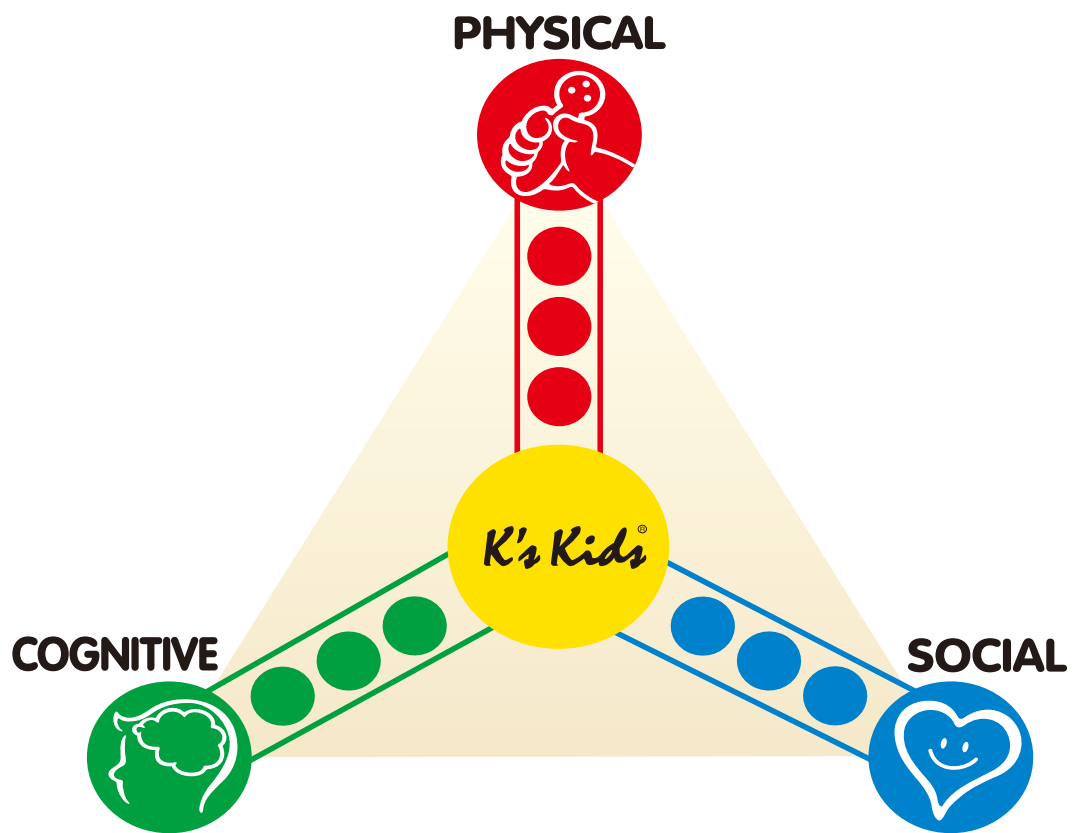

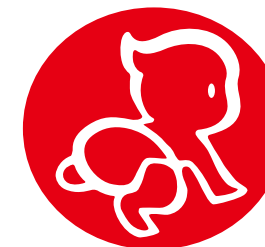
K's Kids Learning Triangle®

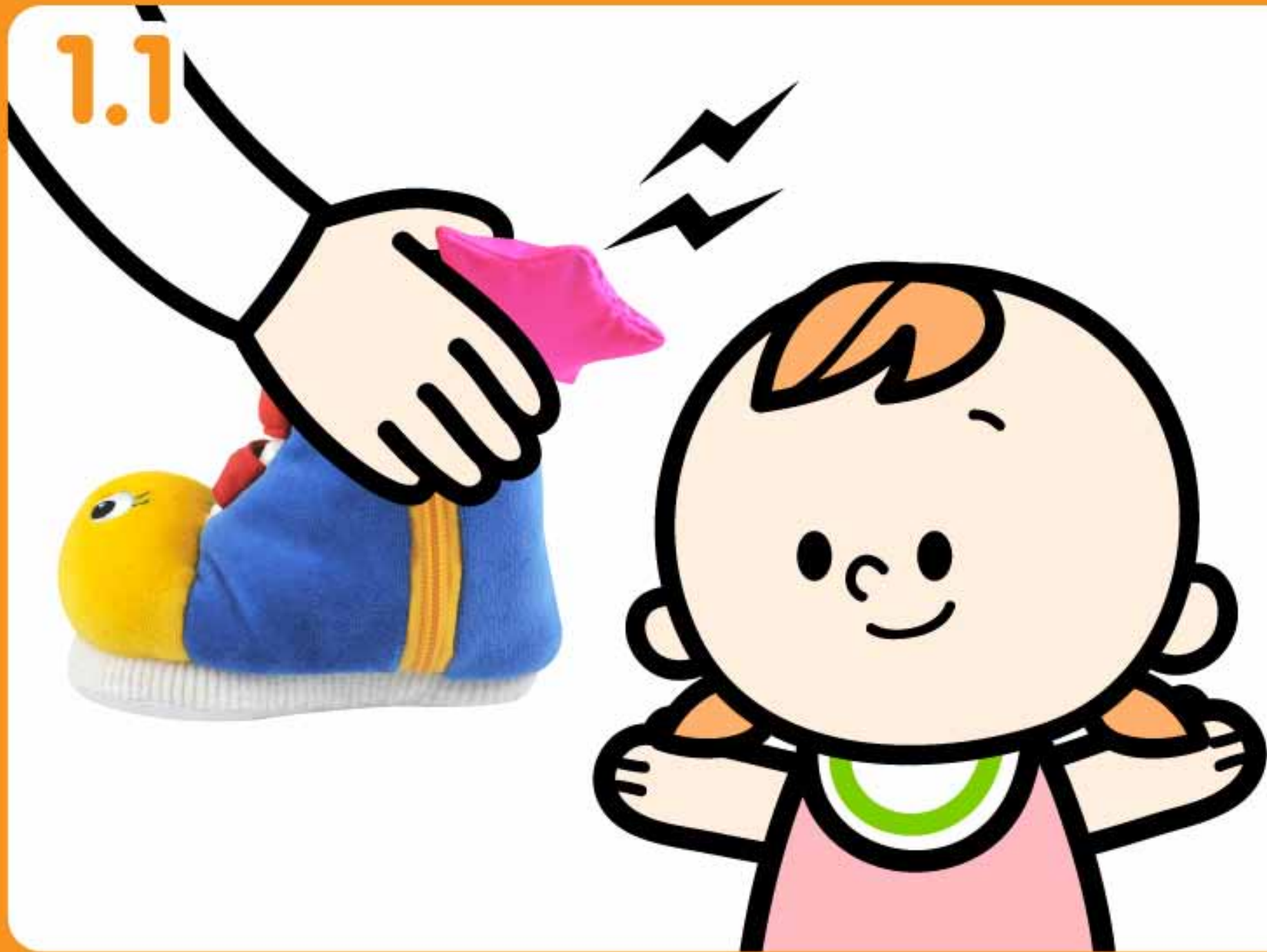
Activity 1.1
