





Objective: Listening training

Method: Use the rattles, squeakers and crinkle paper


to make sounds to the right and left side of


your child's head. Then observe if your child

teether.







hold the inchworm with one or both hands.


Then they can shake it to make different

road.




Activity 2.3


Activity 2.4

encourage your child to point to it on the


inchworm.

teach children to recognize colors.






Activity 3.2
